

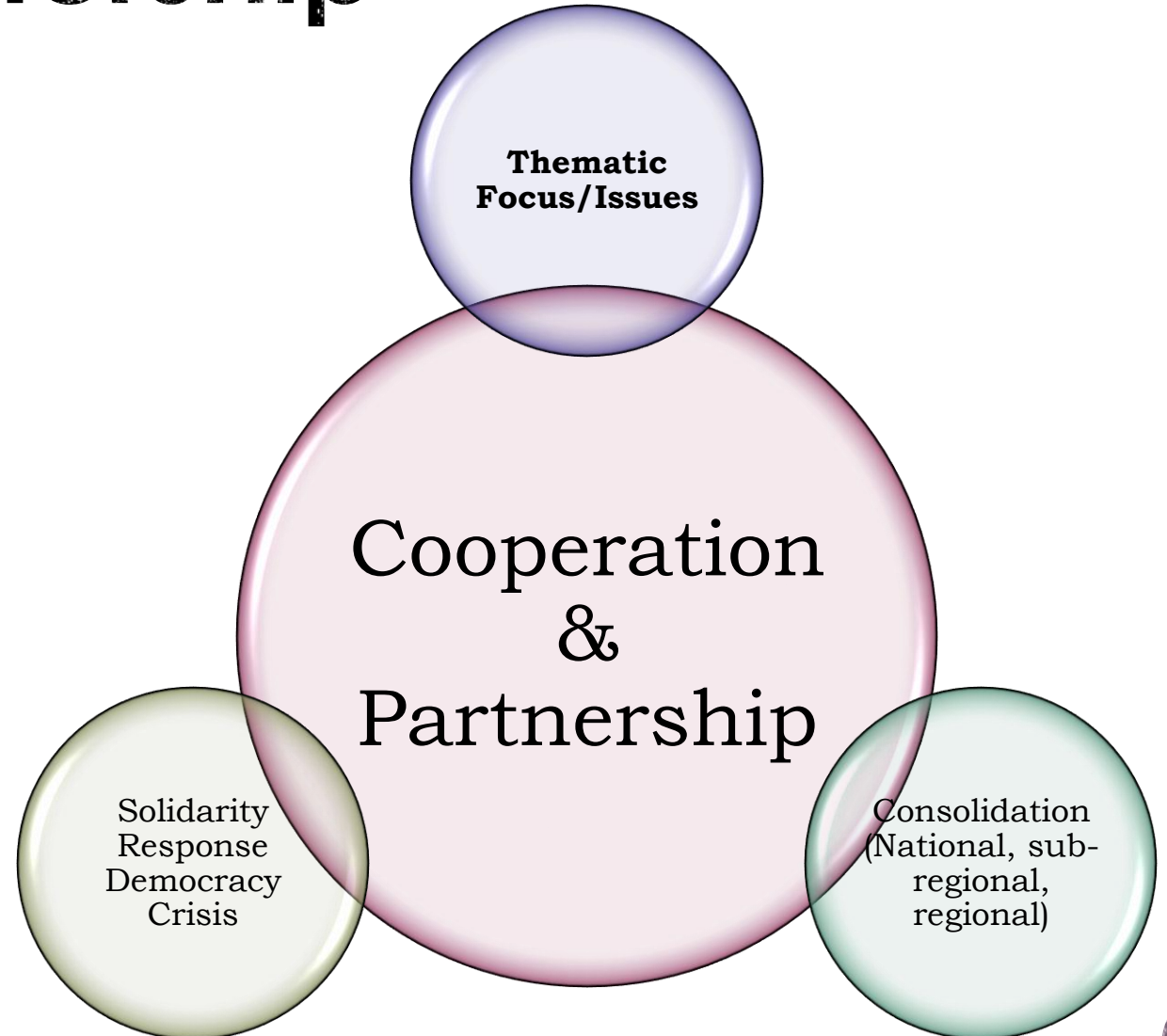

- Ideological differences, and differences in approach on how to promote democratization
- Lack of trust building exercise among civil society
